

BOROUGH OF TELFORD AND WREKIN
FOOTPATH ON SILKIN WAY, MADELEY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2019

The Borough of Telford and Wrekin (hereinafter referred to as ‘the Council’) being the highway authority for the length of footway specified in the Schedule to this Order, are satisfied that the pedestrian traffic in the said length of footway should be prohibited by reason of works being proposed to be executed on or near the said length of road.

The Council, in exercise of their powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall proceed on foot in the length of footway specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Order shall come into operation on **27 July 2020** and may be cited as the Borough of Telford and Wrekin Silkin Way Footpath Madeley (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians) Order 2020.
3. The diversion route for pedestrians will be signed on site.
4. Access will be maintained, whenever reasonably possible, over the length of the closure.

This Order will become operative on **27 July 2020** and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months.
